BEFORE & AFTER TREATMENT INFORMATION BEES & WASPS

AFTER YOUR SERVICE

- Remain away from the nest for upto 24-48 hours.
- Prevent future access by other bees & or wasps by sealing holes and gaps in brickwork, and weep holes.
- Do not eat any honey created from bees that have been treated.
- You can remove the bee nest if you wish 48 hours after the treatment.
- Wasp nests can be covered over if you wish 48 hours after the treatment.
- If you remove a nest we suggest to wear gloves.

PRIOR TO YOUR SERVICE

- Locate the Bee or Wasp nest that the technicians are treating.
- In some cases, bees may just be “swarming” and there may not be a hive on the premises, therefore the Scorpion technicians won’t be able to treat.
- The method of eradication differs depending on the location and size. Most wasp nests are eradicated using a commercial chemical powder.
- If the bee hive is able to be relocated Scorpion will contact local Bee Keepers.
- Pet bowls, uncleaned BBQ’S and any other food source, may be attracting wasps, but unfortunately there is generally no reason for them nesting on your property.
- Please don’t approach wasps or bee nests, wasps in particular can be quite aggressive.

How do I know if I’m allergic?

If you haven’t been stung by a bee before you are unlikely to be allergic to the venom. We do not know why some people are allergic and some people aren’t, however there is a treatment called immunotherapy, which involves, regular, small administrations of venom.
