Rodents – Rats & Mice

The pest technician will complete a comprehensive inspection of the property to determine the best method of application. This may include a combination of rodent stations and traps.

Before treatment

- Complete a general cleaning of your property.
- Remove food items from bench tops including pet food and water.
- Ensure pest technician has access to all areas of the house that is being treated, this may include the sub floor, roof cavity and sheds.
- If you have dogs or cats and are having the subfloor baited, ensure they do not have access to this area.
- Cut back overhanging foliage from eaves and walls.

After treatment

- Baiting and trapping will kill rodents, however if conditions are favourable i.e. there is an easily accessible source of food or water, more may return.
- It may take up to 21 days for the treatment to take its full effect. You may still see or hear signs of rodent activity immediately after the treatment, but these will diminish and cease after a few weeks. In rare cases, rodent infestation can be extreme, and a new method of control may be required to get rid of them.
- Please keep pets and children away from the stations and baited areas.

Did you know?
