

## Customer Prepare & Post treatment Tips



### Rodents – Rats & Mice

The pest technician will complete a comprehensive inspection of the property to determine the best method of application. Treatment methods will differ depending on the severity of infestation, the area of application and type of Rodent. The products used may include baits, lockable station's, or traps.

#### Prior to your service

- Complete a general cleaning of your property.
- Remove any existing food and water sources, such as scraps and pet bowls.
- Ensure the Pest technician has access to all areas of the house that is being treated, this may include the subfloor area, roof cavity or in sheds.
- If you have dogs or cats and are having the subfloor baited, ensure they do not have access to this area.
- Cut back overhanging foliage from eaves and walls.

#### Post Treatment

- Baiting and trapping will kill rodents, however if conditions are favourable i.e. there is an easily accessible source of food and water, more may return.
- It may take up to 21 days for the treatment to take its full effect. You may still see or hear signs of rodent activity immediately after the treatment, but these will diminish and cease after a few weeks. In rare cases, rodent infestation can be extreme, and a new method of control may be required to get rid of them.
- Keep pets and children away from the stations and baited areas.
